

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that for the reasons set forth on the record by the Court, the plaintiff is entitled to judgment in his favor, against the defendant, Ford Motor Company, for the following, pursuant to sec. 218.0171(7), Wis. Stats. and sec. 807.01, Wis. Stats.:

1. \$34,384.08 for twice the amount of the plaintiff's pecuniary loss;
2. \$1,181.64 for pre-judgment interest at 5% (from 8/13/03 to 4/27/04);
3. \$4,257.00 for pre-judgment interest at 12% (from 4/28/04 to 5/19/05);
4. \$14,258.10 for statutory costs;
5. \$6,802.88 for litigation costs; and
6. \$114,690.25 for attorney fees;

that the Clerk of Circuit Court for Waukesha County shall enter judgment accordingly in favor of the plaintiff and against the defendant, Ford Motor Company, for the total sum of \$175,573.95 (the total of the above) forthwith.
